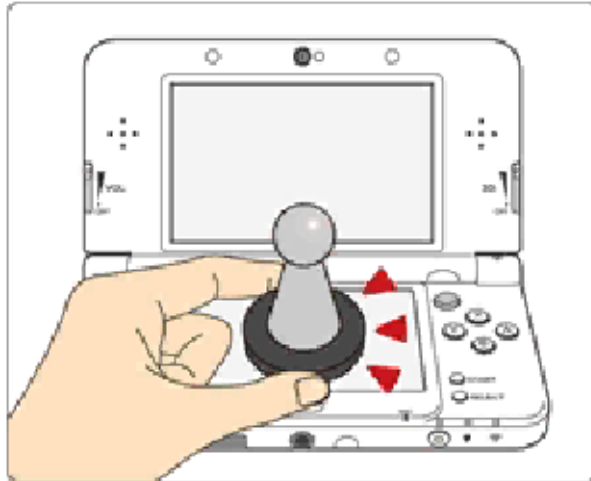

- Seasons and the other characters' clothes will change; events will take place in accordance with real-world time. Altering the in-game date or time will temporarily stop these events from taking place.





Saving Data

Deleting Data

From the Title Menu select "Other", then "Manage Data", and then "Delete Save File" to delete your save data for this software.

- ◆ Deleted data cannot be recovered, so be careful when deleting data.

- Do not turn the power off, reset the system or remove Game Cards/SD Cards while saving. Make sure not to get dirt in the terminals. These actions could result in permanent data loss.
- Do not use external accessories or software to modify your save data, as this can lead to an inability to progress or loss of save data. Any modification is permanent, so be careful.

Recommendations

Try It On!


A recommendation with confidence. If the customer likes it, they'll be very pleased.

- ◆ If the recommended item is not what the customer requested, they may leave without purchasing anything. However, some customers may still purchase items even if they are different to what they had originally requested.

Take A Look!

Let the customer think about a recommendation before trying it on. Even if you get the order wrong at first, you will get up to two more chances to get it right.

◆ Touch , then "Memo" to bring up a hint.

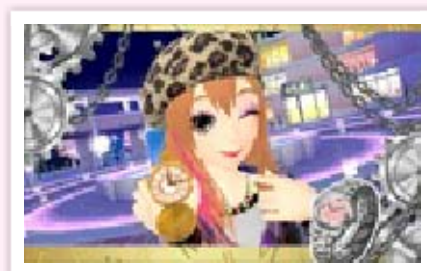
New Make-up Sets

Commissions

Design new items to match requests from existing brands.

Design an Emblem

Draw an emblem for your brand. Although you can redraw it as often as you like, you can only save one emblem at a time.

	The pattern
	The base colour of the pattern
	The second pattern colour
	The base colour of the item

③ If the design is being made in Free Design you can attach your Emblem and decide the price of the item. You can then name the item.

amiibo Visiting your Boutique

- ① Select "amiibo" from your phone menu.
- ② Touch an amiibo to the NFC area on the lower screen of your New Nintendo 3DS or to your Nintendo 3DS NFC Reader/Writer.
- ③ A Mii customer will come to your shop.
- ④ If you make the customer happy, they will give you a special item that they are wearing.

- You can play with the same amiibo multiple times to get different colour variations of the item.
- The customer that comes into the shop will be based on the Mii of the amiibo owner.



Caprice Chalet is a place where you can create rooms to your liking. As well as the characters of the city coming to your rooms, you can also exchange these rooms with other players via wireless communication.



1 Chalet (p. 22)

Here you can create rooms and manage the Chalet.

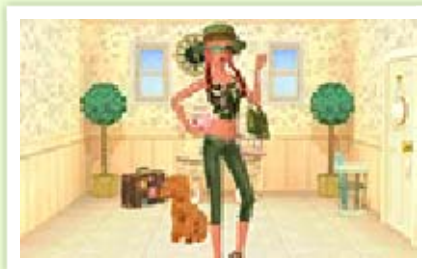

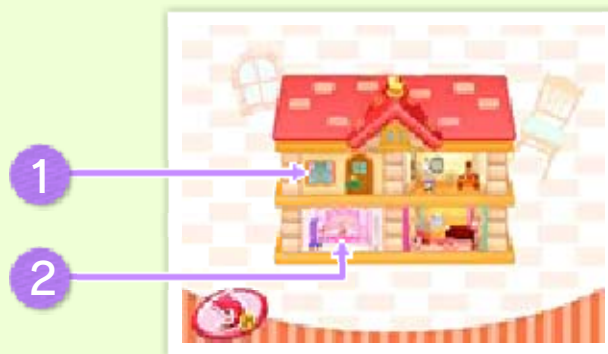

Miniature Posters

By selecting "Create a Poster" at Dollshouse Miniatures you can make a Miniature Poster out of one of your photos. You can then hang this Miniature Poster on the wall in rooms you create in the Chalet.

3 Miniature Box

Take your miniatures out of here.




- ◆ Touching ●, ● or ● spots will also open your Miniature Box.





Place Objects





- ① Touch ,  or .



- ② Select the object you want to place and touch "Ok".



- ③ Slide the  or  to the position you like, then touch "Place".



More Decorating Tips

- Touching 🔄 and 🔄 or pressing [L] and [R] will rotate the selected object.
- Slide an object to 🗑️ to put it away.
- Slide an object to 🟢 if you need to put it to one side for a moment.
- Although 🟡 and 🔵 can be placed next to one another, there are objects that need a small gap between them.



Placing Bits & Bobs



Certain small objects can be placed on top of tables and other miniature furniture items.

- 1 Select 🟡 or 🔵 and touch "Bits & Bobs".



- 2 Select the 🟡 and the miniature you want to place, then touch "Ok".





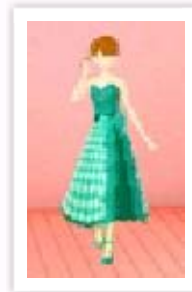
Placing Clothes



Clothes can be placed on miniatures such as busts and clothes racks. The directions are the same as for Placing Bits & Bobs.

Miniature Mannequins

There are special mannequins that can be dressed with the clothes you own and the items you have designed. When used with wireless communication, clothes on these Miniature Mannequins can be bought by anyone.



Swap Rooms (Online Play)



Connect to the internet and share rooms with other far away players. Select "Connect" from your phone menu and then "Swap Rooms".

Share Room

Upload rooms that you have created to the internet to be shared with other players.

- ① After selecting a room, you can check it before selecting "Ok".
- ② When a room is uploaded, the Room Address will be displayed.

Room Address

Give this to other people and they will be able to download your room.

- ◆ The room address is unique to each Nintendo 3DS system. It can be checked in your profile (p. 22) under Online Exhibit.
- ◆ Rooms can be uploaded as often as you like.

Download Room

Receive rooms from other players. You will need to know their room address.

- 1 Enter the room address, check it, and touch "Ok".
- 2 Rooms you receive will be saved to your Spare Rooms (p. 22).

Shopping in Other Player's Rooms

Rooms you receive can be placed in the Dollshouse in the Chalet. If you go into these rooms afterwards you will be able to buy things from them.

Shared Rooms

Here you can check the rooms that you've uploaded via Share Room, as well as cancel sharing it by selecting "End Exhibit".





Go Out (Local Play)



If you and a friend each have your own copy of the game, you can travel to each other's cities for fun and adventure. You can then do things together such as take photos and visit the Caprice Chalet.

Open Showroom



Items such as clothes, miniatures, hairstyles, and make-up sets can be purchased from the hosting player's Caprice Chalet.

◆ Items that get sold to another player won't be lost.

Contests (Online Play)



Connect to the internet and participate in contests held through Miiverse. You can also hold your own contests.

About Contests

Contestants all submit photos to match a particular theme. The player holding the contest then selects their favourite photos.

Opening Contests

Decide on the following settings when opening a contest.

◆ You'll need to enter a title.



1 Title

Set a name for your contest.

2 Comment

Enter a description of your contest.

You can also add a room address (p. 25) and details about your outfit.

- ◆ Only the names of items that have been photographed in the Photo Studio can be added.

3 Photo

You can add a photo to the description.

4 Check Photo and Comment

Touch this to switch the upper screen.




Choose Your Favourites



The host of the contest can pick their favourite photos.

How to Choose

- 1 Select the photo you want to choose and touch .



- 2 Enter a comment and touch "Ok".



Interact with Nearby Players (StreetPass)

If you pass by another player who has StreetPass registered for this software, the following will happen automatically:

- Your profile and the room you have set to share in Spare Rooms will be exchanged.
- Their in-game character will come to your shop as a customer.



Activating StreetPass

You can activate StreetPass once you have created a room. Go to the Chalet in Caprice Chalet, then select the room you want to share by selecting "Spare Rooms", then touch "Use StreetPass".

- ◆ To disable StreetPass, touch "Don't Use StreetPass".





Receive Notifications and Posters (SpotPass)



While the system is in Sleep Mode, and even while the software is not running, the SpotPass™ feature will periodically connect to the internet (if available). You might receive notifications and posters that will be hung around the city when you next launch the software!

- ◆ Data received via SpotPass will be saved to the SD Card, so make sure you always have an SD Card inserted in your system.



Using SpotPass

From the title menu select "Other", then "SpotPass", and then "Use SpotPass".

- ◆ Select "Don't Use SpotPass" to disable SpotPass.





Add New Items



Items can be obtained from the Nintendo eShop (internet connection required). There are items free to download and Nintendo may offer items that can be purchased.

- It is also necessary to be connected to the internet when adding items with QR Code patterns.

How To Get Add-on Items

- 1 Select "Add-on Items" from the title menu.
- 2 Select "Select Add-on Items".
- 3 Select the Add-on Item you would like, then select "Proceed" or press START on your Nintendo 3DS system.
- 4 From here on, please follow the on-screen instructions.

About Downloading/Purchasing Items

- You can view your past downloads/purchases in Nintendo eShop's Account Activity section.
- Purchased/downloaded items can be used on the Nintendo 3DS system used to purchase/download them. Purchased/downloaded items will be saved to the SD Card but if you insert the SD Card into another system they will not be available on that system.
