

Saving Data

Save your current progress by touching the Save icon in the Professor's Trunk (p. 9).

- You can create up to three save files.
- ◆ SpotPass™ (p. 23) data will be saved to the SD Card. Please be careful when inserting and removing SD Cards.







Zooming

Talking

When the magnifying glass turns orange (Q) over a person, tap the lower screen to



start a conversation with them. Touch the lower screen or press (A) to advance the dialogue. Even if you've already spoken to someone once, they may say something different the next time you talk to them.

Hidden Objects

Various things, such as hint coins and puzzles, are hidden on the upper screen. Be sure to search every last nook and cranny! The appearance of the magnifying glass icon will change in various ways when you move it over certain points. Checking these points may reveal hidden items.




