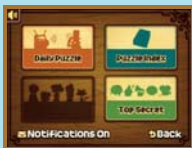

Receive Notifications

SpotPass

When SpotPass™ is active, your system will automatically search for and connect to the nearest wireless access point in order to receive notifications. This will occur while your system is in Sleep Mode, even when the game is not running.

Activating/Deactivating SpotPass: Enter the Bonuses section and touch **NOTIFICATIONS ON** or **NOTIFICATIONS OFF** to toggle this setting.

Open the trunk and touch  to enter the Treasure Hunt section.

To communicate using this feature, all players must activate StreetPass for this software.

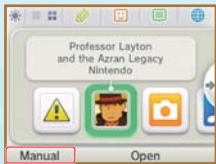
